CRISP CONDENSATIONS. The value of a pack of homids is revealed by the sale of one recognized as among the finest in England for 3,000 guineas. The Japanese government has sent two engineers to Berlin to study the telephone system, with a view of establishing a line in Japan. At the recent annual Prussian Festival of Orders, 1,496 medals, crosses, stars and the like were given out. Court Preacher Stocker received the order of the Red Eagle of the third class. A medicament more powerful than quinine in counteracting fevers is said to have been discovered in Mexico. It is a plant called the pomblano, the root of which contains a substance analogous to quinine.

A Bible has just been rediscovered in the Vatican library which is in Hebrew. It is supposed to be the oldest in the world and is valued at \$100,000.
