

The Velvet Bean.

Rev. C. W. Campbell called at the Signal office Tuesday with the root of the velvet bean plant which he planted in his yard early in the spring. The root was an exceptionally heavy one, and betokens the plant a most hardy one. From one bean a vine grew that covered a fence forty feet long and six feet high, then spreading out laterally.

For farmers having stock no better forage could be found than this plant. It spreads so rapidly and needs so little attention that it pays well. The beans should be put in the ground several feet apart, and after a good growth has been attained the stock can be turned in on it without preventing further growth. It is continually putting out new shoots and would afford fresh forage all the time. The stock also relish it when dried. Like the cow pea, it can be cut and stacked and used during the winter. An acre planted to velvet beans will afford feed for a good many cattle. It is worth trying. The cattle like it better than hay, and it produces better results.—Crowley Signal.

In the Government crop estimate for November the cotton crop for this year is put at 9,500,000 bales, with indications pointing to 9,000,000.—Neill the British crop guesser estimates a 12,000,000 bale crop. Despite the predictions of this dire enemy of the southern cotton planter the price of the staple is slowly rising. A little matter of 2,500,000 bales is not going to worry the champion guesser any. Lying is his one strong point. He tells one and then sticks to it regardless of facts.

The taking of the Cuban census is looked upon as a step preparatory to annexation; that is, if the Cubans show a disposition to come into the United States, as the administration leaders assert they will do, a proposition will be made to Congress to make the island at once a part of the territory of this country. Although the war resolutions stated that the island would be independent, there is a general belief that it will be annexed.

George Washington's Memorial Association is endeavoring to procure a general observance of December 14, instant, the one hundredth anniversary of Washington's death. Exercises will be held in many of the States under the supervision of the State Chairman of the Association, but it is deemed eminently suitable that a commemoration of especial solemnity and importance should take place at the National Capital.
