DESTROY MOSQUITOES.

The Louisiana State Board of Health adopted the following resolutions at its last meeting:

Whereas: It has been proven that malarial fever and yellow fever are transmitted by mosquitoes and that other fevers may be possibly transmitted by them, be it

Resolved: That the Louisiana State Board of Health most emphatically urges all physicians and all other persons attending patients with fever to carefully keep a well tacked bar over such patients, especially during the first four days of their illness and as far as practicable destroy mosquitoes about the patient's bed and room. This precaution should be particularly observed from the 1st of April to Nov. 30th.

Resolved further: That a copy of these resolutions be sent to all the Health Official and all the Physicians in the State.

Resolved further: That a copy of these resolutions be sent to all the newspapers of the state with special request to publish the same.
