PAVING OF SIDEWALKS

An ordinance has just been presented to the Council for the paving of Wagner street from Patterson to Newton street; this we believe has reference to the paving of the sidewalks and the fact that petitions for the paving of the sidewalks of other streets in our district are before the Council will mean that if all of the ordinances be passed, we will be placed in a position to make demand upon our National Government for the extension of our Free Mail delivery limits.

For a good many years Algiers had five mail carriers, but after an investigation by one of the inspectors of the Post Office Department, one of our mail carriers was taken away, for the fact that we did not have sufficient sidewalks to justify the delivery of the mails, nor could we compel the government to make these deliveries on account of the fact that the absence of the sidewalks was in direct violation of one of the rules governing the free distribution of mails.

Not only did Algiers suffer but the city proper lost many mail carriers and the curtailment of the force meant the loss of considerable money to our city.

The compulsory building of sidewalks through petition of the property holders means that our citizens who live in the outskirts of the town will be given the same mail facilities as those living on a paved street and who are now within the free delivery limits.

In passing these ordinances we believe that some attention should be given to the sidewalks in Algiers parallel with our paved streets. In many instances the sidewalks are in such poor condition that the people prefer to walk in the street on account of it being a better thoroughfare. There are several squares within only a few blocks of the post office where there never has been a sidewalk and in some of these places there are not even planks, and in muddy weather pedestrians must go in some other direction.

We trust that the people in our district who are interested in this matter will freely circulate petitions for the paving of sidewalks where the sidewalks are mostly needed.

FEEDING JOHNNY

An expert of the department of agriculture who has been preparing menus for children is quoted as giving the following for a child of six to nine years:

BREAKFAST—Orange of medium size, cooked oatmeal, one-third cup; milk and cream mixed, one-half cup; toast, one slice; butter, one-half cubic inch; milk to drink, one glass.

DINNER—White fish, one-half ounce edible portion; potato, cooked in milk, three-eighths cupful; bread, one slice; butter for bread and potato, one cubic inch; rice pudding, one-half cupful.

SUPPER—Egg, cooked, one slice; butter, one-half inch; milk, one glass; prunes, three, cooked with one-half level tablespoon of sugar; cookies.
