North American Moose.

Father of Punctuation.
The present system of punctuation, now used in all modern languages with but insignificant variations, was introduced in the first half of the fifteenth century by a Venetian printer named Aldus Manutius. He is the real father of punctuation marks--of the full stop, comma, semicolon, colon, question and exclamation marks, apostrophe and inverted commas.
