FIVE MILE STRIP TO BE SURFACED WITH GRAVEL, IF—

According to Mr. J. F. Campbell of the J. D. O'Riley Co. road contractors, the big job of building the five-mile stretch across the marsh between Houma and Bayou Blue to a point a short distance within the parish of Lafourche, which will form connection with the New Orleans highway, will be underway during the next few days. It would have started this past week but for the completion of certain matters of detail between the Police Jury of this parish and that of the Parish of Lafourche.

The five mile road strip, for which a tax was voted five years ago, will take about six months to complete after work is well organized and underway. It will be surfaced with gravel, if plans of the Police Jury are carried out, which depends entirely upon the ability of the railroad companies to effect delivery of gravel from the pits.

LAFOURCHE CO-OPERATES.

The Police Jury of Lafourche signed a contract Wednesday with the Terrebonne Police Jury to co-operate in the completion of the Houma Raceland road, by accepting the sum nineteen thousand dollars from the Parish of Terrebonne to be turned over by the Lafourche parish to the Federal Aid Department, which in turn will give a like sum to carry the road into Lafourche Parish far enough to connect with a dirt road, linking the Houma road with the New Orleans highway.
