District Court.

In the case of A. M. Goodwyn, charged with killing E. L. Stucky, the attorneys for Goodwyn filed a motion to quash the indictment. Trial of the motion was set for Thursday, and Judge Blackman sustained the motion, setting aside the indictment. Defendant's attorneys embodied in their motion to quash three allegations affecting four of the grand jurors, but on trial withdrew all but one, relating to R. A. Killingsworth, against whom a charge of assault and battery is pending in Winn parish.

The district attorney moved that all the other indictments found by the grand jury also be set aside, which the court so ordered.

Judge Blackman removed the disqualified juror and O. J. Hattaway was drawn to serve as grand juror in his stead. The jury was re-empaneled, and charged to proceed with a new investigation of the cases set aside. After being in session six or seven hours, the grand jury came into court about dark and made their final report. The report states that they examined 29 cases, finding 5 true bills and 24 no bills. They again call attention to the necessity for repairs to the lower part of the jail. These of \$22,444.46 reported to be in the hands of the parish treasurer.

The courts instructed the minutes to be written up by the clerk, which were signed by the Judge in time to catch the train for Alexandria at 8 o'clock Thursday night.

Two of the three bills reported by the grand jury were renewals of the bills against A. M. Goodwyn and Jules Lavapere.

The criminal business disposed of by the court for the week is as follows: L. S. Burns pleaded guilty to retailing liquor without license in four cases, and was fined \$250 and costs in each case, or three months imprisonment in each case on failure to pay fine and cost. Burr McKinney, tried by jury for the killing of Ed Glover, was acquitted.

Wat Hemphill and Robert Cappa, tried on the charge of larceny, were acquitted. Columbus Devore, Prince Koen and Frank Hamill, boys, respectively about 12, 14 and 15 years, pleaded guilty to attempt to injure the track and property of the Iron Mountain & Southern railway company, and were sentenced to five months in the parish jail.
