

## Some Confederate History.

Last Wednesday, April 12th, was the semi-centennial of the bombardment of Fort Sumpter. On that date, fifty years ago, General Beauregard fired the first gun, which reverberated around the world and produced the most sanguinary civil conflict in all the annals of warfare.

But a Massachusetts regiment passing through Baltimore to Washington City, had been stoned and clubbed by the populace before that date. So had also Mr. Jackson, proprietor of the

Marshall House, of Alexandria, Va., been shot to death by the Ellsworth Zouaves of Chicago, in advance of that date. One of the Zouaves hauled down a Confederate flag from the flag staff of the hotel, when Mr. Jackson deliberately shot him to death. His comrades as promptly returned the fire and killed Mr. Jackson. This was really the first blood shed during the Civil War, in which there was greater loss of life and heavier expenditure of treasure than in all the civil conflicts of the world combined. —Alexandria Democrat.

## Greatest Cathedral in the New World.

America's grandest cathedral, on Morningside Heights, New York city, was dedicated April 19th. Nineteen years have passed since the work on the building was begun; another ten years will be occupied, perhaps, in completing it.

Four millions have been expended thus far, and the cost will probably amount to \$10,000,000. The greatest cathedrals of the Old World are the only churches that surpass, the Church of St. John the Divine, as the new American cathedral is known. The whole religious world joins with the Protestant Episcopal Church in interest in the dedication.
