I have made a very careful inspection of everything connected with your plant and find the machinery and equipment as follows: Boiler—The Babcock and Wilcox boiler is in good condition.

The Murphy boiler is leaking badly and is in need of repairs.

The Electric Light engine is in first class condition as is the dynamo it runs, but the exciter is in need of some minor repairs. This engine and dynamo while in every respect a first class piece of machinery is too large to use on the smaller loads.

The air-compressor that is used to pump water from the well is in about as bad a condition as a piece of machinery can get and still run. The water pump is in a worse condition than the air-compressor and is likely to break down any minute and leave the City with no water supply until it can be patched up again. There is an awful waste of fuel in this part of the plant and immediate steps should be taken to install electrically driven pump and compressor.

The outside wiring is in bad condition. There are only 27 of the arc lamps in shape to burn and most of these need new shunt coils and can not give the proper amount of light until they get them. The balance of the arc lamps have been replaced by tungsten lamps put up in a temporary manner. There is no protection against lightning on the outside lines but I have arranged to put up lightning arresters without further delay.

I have started to check up the light meters and find that most of them are fast. A great many meters are going to burn out and will have to be replaced from time to time. There are also a number of customers that have no meters. There are 327 water customers this month. Out of this number there are only 81 that had meters that would register. The rest either have dead meters or no meters at all. It will cost a great deal of money to fix these meters and I am going to try for the present to fix the meters on the customers known to be large users of water as it is impossible to correct them all. The total amount of water registered by the water meters in service amounted to 1,043,875 gallons or about one-quarter of the total amount of water that was pumped. There was probably a considerable loss of revenue in this part of the service.

A very large part of the loss this month has been due to the fan service which can not be expected to pay as the engine is too large to run with no load and if the fan service is continued the loss is bound to continue.

I wish to also report that the horse we have been using on our trouble wagon died last night in spite of all we could do for him and some arrangement should be made to have him replaced.

Sir: I have your verbal request of this date, asking for a written opinion from me on the two propositions, viz:

1. "Can the Board of Aldermen issue certificates of indebtedness, pledging future revenues of the city, in payment of debts contracted prior to the issuance of such certificates?"

2. "Has the city a legal right to assume the indebtedness of an independent chartered organization? Or, of individuals?"

As to the first proposition, I might almost answer it by quoting Section 31 of the City Charter, which reads as follows: "All expenditures of money for any purpose whatever, shall be in pursuance of a specific appropriation made by order, and in no other manner. Every warrant drawn on the treasury shall express on its face to whom issued and for what purpose allowed; and the ordinance authorizing its issue shall be cited by minute book and page, in or upon it."

Along this line, Section 2448, of the Revised Statutes of this State, provides: "The Police Juries of the several parishes, and the constituted authorities of incorporated towns
