Mr. McCaffery offered the following ordinance and upon being duly read was adopted, to-wit:

AN ORDINANCE.
 An ordinance regulating the use of automobiles throughout the parish of St. Landry, and on the public roads and highways of said parish:

Section 1. That all owners of automobiles in the Parish of St. Landry, be and they are hereby required, before operating or driving their said machine over any of the public roads or highways of said parish, to procure from the Clerk of the Police Jury a tag on which shall be stamped, the Parish of St. Landry and the number of said tag.

Section 2. That all automobile owners are hereby required to carry said tag publicly exposed, either in the front or the rear of his machine, and in such a position as to be seen by external observation.

Section 3. That the Clerk of this body be and he is hereby directed to have prepared 200 tin tags, on which shall be stamped the words, "St. Landry Parish" and numbered from 1 to 200 inclusive, for delivery to such automobile owners as may apply for such tags, and said Clerk upon payment to him of the actual cost of such tags, shall deliver to each applicant a tag, and shall record in a book kept for that purpose, the name of such applicant, the number of the tag so issued and the date of the issuance of the same.

Section 4. That no automobile shall be driven on the public roads of this parish at a greater speed than 25 miles per hour.

Section 5. That when crossing or passing vehicles drawn by animals, automobiles shall not be driven at a greater speed than 10 miles per hour, and should animals attached to vehicles become frightened, the driver or chauffeur of the automobile shall further slacken the speed of his machine so as to ensure the safety of occupants of the vehicles drawn by such animals. It being the intention of this ordinance to charge the drivers of automobiles with the duty of observing whether animals attached to vehicles crossed or passed by them have become frightened and to take such precaution as is necessary to prevent any injury to the occupants of the vehicle drawn by such frightened animal or animals.

Section 6. That when approaching any bend in the road, or any cross road, the drivers of automobiles be and they are hereby required to sound their horns and to check the speed of their machines as a warning to travelers on such highways.

Section 7. That all persons violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall on conviction, be fined in a sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, or imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days, or both at the discretion of the court. prosecution to be by indictment or information in any court of competent jurisdiction;

Section 8. Be it further ordained, that this ordinance take effect sixty days after its passage, and all ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.


