

Order Fixing Terms of Court in The Sixteenth Judicial District Court, State of Louisiana.

It is hereby ordered that the District Court in and for the Sixteenth Judicial District of the State of Louisiana, do open on the 15th day of September, and adjourn on the 15th day of July of each and every year and remain in session throughout the District during said period.

It is, however, for the purpose of convenience, further ordered that said ten months period be subdivided into terms as follows, to-wit:

St. Landry 3rd. Monday in September, Civil term for two weeks.

Evangeline 5th. Monday in September, Civil term for one week.

St. Landry 1st. Monday in October, Criminal term for five weeks.

Evangeline 2nd. Monday in November, Criminal term for five weeks.

St. Landry 3rd. Monday in December, Civil term for four weeks.

Evangeline 2nd. Monday in January, Civil term for four weeks.

St. Landry 2nd. Monday in February, Criminal term for four weeks.

Evangeline 2nd. Monday in March, Criminal term for four weeks.

St. Landry 1st. Monday in April, Civil term for four weeks.

Evangeline 1st. Monday in May, Civil term for four weeks.

St. Landry 1st. Monday in June, Civil term for four weeks.

Evangeline 5th. Monday in June, Civil term to July 15th.

The number of weeks opposite each term merely indicates the time allotted for that term.

Therefore, if the condition of the docket does not justify the holding of Court for the full term, it may be adjourned prior to the expiration of the time allotted.

Likewise, in order to complete any case on trial, if it be advisable that a term be prolonged beyond the time allotted, it may be prolonged, without any order to that effect.

Nothing herein shall be construed as preventing Court from being held in any parish of the District, as the public business may require, notwithstanding the fixing of terms, nor to prevent the opening of Court for the trial and disposition of misdemeanor cases during the two months vacation period, nor from wholly or partially converting a jury term into a non-jury term, or vice versa.

Whenever the day for opening Court falls in a legal holiday, Court will convene instead on the first legal day following.



Cheese Squares

Out of a pint of milk take enough to wet up a quarter of a cup each of flour and corn starch, seasoned with half a teaspoonful each of salt paprika. Add this to the remainder of the scalded in a double boiler. Stir constantly until the mixture thickens, then occasionally for twenty minutes. Add yolks of two eggs beaten up with a quarter cup of creamed butter and half a cup of grated cheese. As soon as these are cooked, turn out into a shallow pan and when cold cut in shapes, lay these in a baking pan apart from from each other; cover thickly with grated cheese; reheat and brown in a hot oven.
