SPECIAL ASSESSMENT ORDINANCE NUMBER ONE.

No. 1 of 1914. To levy a special assessment on the property abutting Court street from Chaney street to Bellevue street; Bellevue street from Market street to M. L. & T. R. & S. S. Co. Main street from Landry street to Church street; Madison street; Landry street from Main street to Oak street; Landry street from Market street to Bullard Avenue, of the City of Opelousas, Louisiana, for the purpose of defraying the cost of construction of Gravel Pavement on said streets, under contract by the Mayor of the City of Opelousas, Louisiana, with H. T. Clark, Contractor, of date November 5, 1913, and to prorate the cost of construction of said Gravel Pavement between the abutting property owners in the proportion owned by them, and to provide the manner of ensuring payment of said special assessment, and authorizing the Mayor of the City of Opelousas, Louisiana, to issue certificates of indebtedness to cover the deferred payments due by the respective property owners on account of the construction of said pavements.
