AN ORDINANCE To create a Road District in the Fourth Police Jury Ward of the Parish of St. Landry; to fix the limits and boundaries of said Road District and to designate the name by which such district shall be known. Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Police Jury of the parish of St. Landry in regular session convened, That pursuant to the authority vested in this body by law, Road District Two of the Fourth Police Jury ward of the parish of St. Landry be and the same is hereby created and its boundaries are hereby fixed as follows, to-wit: Description of Proposed Melville-Palmetto Road District No. Two (2) of the Fourth (4th) Police Jury Ward of St. Landry Parish, Louisiana. Commencing at a point on the west bank of the Atchafalaya River where the north line of T. 4. S. R. 7 E., intersects said River, said point also being the Northeast corner of section two of said township and range, and thence running due west nine and three quarter (9 3/4) miles to the northwest corner of section one (1), in T. 4 S. R. 5 E.; thence running due south eleven (11) miles to the southwest corner of section 25, in T. 5 S. R. 5 E.; thence running due east four (4) miles to the southwest corner of section 28, in T. 5 S. R. 6 E.; thence running due north two (2) miles to the northeast corner of section 21, in T. 5 S. R. 6 E.; thence running due east three (3) miles to the southeast corner of section 13, in T. 5 S. R. 6 E.; thence running due north three (3) miles to the northeast corner of section 4, in T. 5 S. R. 6 E.; thence running due east three and one-half (3 1/2) miles to the west bank of the Atchafalaya River, at a point where the south line of section 26, in T. 4 S. R. 7 E., intersects said River; thence in a northerly direction, following the sinuosities of the west bank of the Atchafalaya, to point of beginning. Said district containing in these boundaries ninety-three (93) square miles, or fifty-nine thousand, eight hundred twenty (59,820) acres Sec. 2. That all ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance, be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this ordinance take effect from and after its promulgation. Adopted May 1, 1916.
