**Concerning the Tropical Disturbance.**

Nothing definite is known as yet, as to the course of the Tropical disturbance that is now centered in the Porto Rico neighborhood. Advices to Displayman Jolley this morning by the Government state that the location reported Tuesday evening as being South of Porto Rico and that the location is still indefinite, other than that it is probably near Haiti, moving Westward. The wind at San Juan, Porto Rico continues to blow from the South-east but has diminished in force. Reports later today may give more definite location on the disturbance.

**STORM BULLETIN  
A Later Storm Bulletin Posted At 10:30 A. M. Wednesday**

Advisory ten a. m.: The tropical disturbance reported Tuesday morning is now central short distance South-east of Jamaica moving westward and the pressure is again falling over eastern Carribean although there is as yet no definite information with respect to formation of fresh disturbance, it is considered dangerous to navigate waters from Yukatan channel eastward to Jamaica during the next twenty four hours.

**The Agricultural Heart of the Nation.**

The South is preeminently an agricultural section and her strides in this direction are truly amazing. In 1915 the gain in the value of all farm crops in the United States over 1914 was \$526,000,000. Of this gain \$317,209,000, or a little over 60 per cent was in the South. Remember the South occupies only one-third the total area of the country and this one-third produced 60 per cent of the agricultural increase. In other words the South is advancing three times as fast agriculturally as the rest of the nation. Nor is this increase due to cotton. The cotton crop was valued at \$750,000,000 while the value of diversified crops, such as grain, sugar, hay, tobacco, vegetables, fruits and so forth, and exclusive of live stock was \$1,957,000,000, or two and one-half times as great as cotton. If we include live stock, the total value of all Southern farm products exclusive of cotton was \$2,850,000,000 in 1915, or nearly four times the value of the cotton crop.
