PROGRESSIVES MEET AT THE COSTELLO

The Congressional Committee of the Progressive Party for the Third Congressional District of Louisiana met in Morgan City at the Costello Hotel Tuesday morning. Candidate Whit. P. Martin was present. The Committee met for organization, following the primary election of September 12th, as is required by law.

Following the legal organization, the Committee proceeded to fill all vacancies existing in the different Parishes, wherever such vacancies might occur. The meeting was presided over by Temporary Chairman Walter A. O'Neil of Baldwin.


