CITY COUNCIL MET

The council of Morgan City met at the City Hall last night for their regular monthly session. Councilmen present were the Hon. Mayor Shannon, O'Brien, Price, Squires and Norman; absent Clements and Jones.

After the reading of the minutes of the previous meeting, which was approved, the bills for the month were read and referred to the usual investigation committees for verification and payment.

A motion was made and carried that a four and one-half mill tax be levied to meet the interest on the assigned bonds and certificates outstanding against the city. The assessment is made against the total city property valuation of \$1,043,000. This assessment is the usual annual special tax to meet the interest each year and means a renewal of the regular tax instead of an increase.

A bid of \$1.39 per cubic yard for washed gravel was submitted by J. W. Thompson, Sand and Gravel concern of Phrophe Island, and, as there was no other bids submitted in response to the advertisement calling for such bids, a motion was made and carried to buy 600 yards of gravel from J. W. Thompson. This washed gravel is to be used in the construction of 1900 feet of city streets beginning at Avoca Crossing and running eastward to the city limits. Estimates furnished by City Engineer Thorpeson fixed the probable cost of this piece of work at \$1000.

Secretary O'Brien read to the Mayor and Council a citation advising them of a suit being brought against the city for \$100.00 by J. W. Thompson for balance claimed as due on sidewalk material which was used by a certain Prayther under contract with Morgan City in 1914 and 1915. The City, it seems, had withheld from accepting the assignment of the certificates covering the amount of the claimed indebtedness because of a counter claim for held by the city against the contractor, Prather. On motion made and carried, the Mayor was authorized to take such steps in the employment of counsel to defend the city in the suit as he thought necessary.

No reports were turned in from outstanding committees and a motion to adjourn was carried.
