POPULAR EXCURSION TO NEW ORLEANS

Sunday, October 8th, 1916.
On Sunday, October 8th, 1916 the Southern Pacific will operate special Excursions to New Orleans and return from Lafayette and stations intermediate. Special train will leave Lafayette at four-thirty (4:30) a. m. stopping at all stations up to Chacahoula, inclusive, to pick up passengers, making no stops from Chacahoula to New Orleans and scheduled to arrive New Orleans at 10:40 a. m. Regular train No 2 will handle excursion passengers from Schriever and points east to New Orleans.
Round-trip fare of \$2.00 will be in effect from Lafayette; \$1.50 from New Iberia; \$1.00 from Morgan City and proportionately low rates from intermediate points. Arrangements have been made to get these passengers into New Orleans as early as possible. This will be the last excursion to be operated into New Orleans this season.
Special trains returning to Lafayette and intermediate points will leave New Orleans same day at 8:45 p. m., stopping at all stations en route.
