**AGREEMENT REACHED**

The Conference Committees of the Senate and House of Representatives reached an agreement late yesterday on the telegraph-telephone legislation. Toll and local exchange phone rates are to be continued four months unless sooner changed by State Commissions. The practical effect of the new law will be the return of the wires to private control at midnight July 31. It is expected that the bill will be signed by the President early in July.

**PREVENTION OF MALARIA AND YELLOW FEVER POSSIBLE**

The second installment of the Review of the work of the Rockefeller Foundation for 1918 points out the possibility of practically eliminating malaria and yellow fever wherever the people of any section of the country are willing to make reasonable efforts to this end. Successful work in this direction has already been conducted in various districts throughout the United States. In these districts by draining or filling pools, by ditching sluggish streams, and by oiling surface water which could not be otherwise dealt with, the breeding of the anopheles (malaria-carrying) mosquito was almost wholly prevented, and thus the sole means by which malaria can be transmitted was eliminated. Tests have been made in four towns in Arkansas and the results, as shown by the

reduced number of calls by physicians on persons suffering from the disease, was striking. In Hamburg, Arkansas, the number of such calls fell from 2312 in 1916 to 59 in 1918, and the work was done at an extremely low cost of 44 cents per capita.

"One could not ask for more convincing proofs," the Review states, "that a community may rid itself of malaria on terms which cannot be wisely rejected. It is not surprising that towns and villages are making appropriations faster than trained sanitarians can be found to undertake the work of malaria control."
