### CHARTER

Of Incorporation of Maxwell & Pringle, Inc.

State of Louisiana, ) No. 60683  
Parish of Rapides, )

**BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED**, That, on this, the 17th day of June, A. D., 1919, before me, Jno. W. Britt, a Notary Public, in and for Rapides Parish, Louisiana, duly commissioned and qualified, personally came and appeared J. P. Maxwell, a resident of Rapides Parish, whose postoffice address is Glenmora, Louisiana; Enoch M. Pringle, a resident of Rapides Parish, Louisiana, whose postoffice address is Glenmora, Louisiana; and J. F. Allen, a resident of Rapides Parish, Louisiana, whose postoffice address is Glenmora, Louisiana, all of full age, who declared unto me, Notary, in the presence of the undersigned competent witnesses, that availing themselves of the provisions of the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Louisiana relative to the formation and organization of corporations, and especially of Act 267 of the General Assembly for the year 1914 and the amendments hereto, they have covenanted and agreed, and do by these presents covenant and agree and bind themselves, as well as all other persons who may hereafter become associated with them, to form and constitute a corporation and body politic in law under the name and for the business purposes and objects hereinafter set forth, and under the following stipulations, articles and conditions, to-wit:

**ARTICLE 1.**  
The name of the corporation is **MAXWELL & PRINGLE, Inc.** incorporated.

**ARTICLE 2.**  
The purposes for which this corporation is formed are to engage in the conduct of a wholesale and retail mercantile brokerage and department store business in the town of Glenmora, Rapides Parish, Louisiana, and at all such other places as the Board of Directors may designate, and in connection with said purposes purchase, hold, acquire and sell or exchange dry goods, groceries, hardware, stationery, cotton, produce, cigars, cigarettes, tobacco, and generally all other articles of commerce handled in connection with the operation of a mercantile, cotton, and department store business in country towns and in connection with kindred lines.

**ARTICLE 3.**  
The amount of the capital stock is Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars divided into and represented by Three Hundred (300) Shares of par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars each, Fifty (50 per cent) of which capital stock has been subscribed and paid for as follows, to-wit:  
The said J. P. Maxwell subscribing for and taking Seventy-four (74) shares.  
The said Enoch M. Pringle subscribing for and taking Seventy-five (75) shares.  
The said J. F. Allen subscribing for and taking One (1) share.

**ARTICLE 4.**  
The domicile of this corporation is Glenmora, Rapides Parish, Louisiana.

**ARTICLE 5.**  
The period of duration of this corporation is ninety-nine (99) years unless sooner dissolved according to law.

**ARTICLE 6.**  
The number of Directors shall be three, and shall, until the first Monday in July, 1920, consist of the said Maxwell, the said Pringle, and the said Allen, or until their successors are elected and qualified. The Board of Directors are invested with all powers of this corporation, subject to such restrictions as may be named in this charter. The

stockholders' meeting for the election of Directors shall be held annually on the first Monday in July at the domicile of the corporation, and notice thereof must be delivered personally by depositing in the postoffice properly addressed to each stockholder at least fifteen days before such meeting.

**ARTICLE 7.**  
The officers of this corporation shall be a President, a Vice-President, and a Secretary-Treasurer, the office of Secretary and Treasurer being vested in one and the same person. The officers shall be elected annually immediately after the election of each new Board of Directors. Until the next election the said Maxwell shall be President, the said Allen Vice-President, and the said Pringle Secretary-Treasurer.

**ARTICLE 8.**  
Service of process shall be made upon the President, or in his absence upon the Vice-President, or in his absence upon the Secretary-Treasurer. Thus done and signed in the presence of the undersigned competent subscribing witnesses, at Glenmora, Louisiana, on this the 17th day of June, A. D., 1919.
