### War Beginning in Washington Parish. Total Extirmination of the Hookworm Hoped For.

EDITOR ERA-LEADER:

Through your good paper, I wish to announce to my friends and acquaintances of Washington parish that I am in the parish again to work with and for all the people of the parish, to continue and bring as near to completion as possible the good work that we started two years ago.

You will doubtless recall that two years ago you saw me teaching, talking and waging war against our common enemy, the hookworms. After using all the time allowed me for this parish, I fully realized that my work had not been finished, but really just begun, however not being able to stay longer I promised to come back again.

Since leaving here I have been through all of the Florida Parishes and four parishes on the west side of the Mississippi river. I have found the work interesting and pleasant everywhere I have been. I remember while in this parish that the sympathy, co-operation and assistance given me in many ways by the physicians, teachers, and the people in general of this parish not only made the work interesting and pleasant for me, but enabled me to do a great

deal more good for the people of the parish. Now that I am here again, I earnestly appeal to the physicians, teachers, preachers, and all the good people of Washington parish to help me in my efforts to remove from your people a disease that is doing untold harm. Why spend \$50,000 to run your schools and allow the hookworm to consume ten thousand of these dollars? Does it seem wise to spend \$75 a month for a teacher to teach children that are not well and healthy? In their lowered health condition the children cannot learn as fast or remember things so well, frequently they fail in their examinations and must take the same grade two years.

Since I have worked here before I am sure a great many people understand what the disease is, how the examination is made, how simple the treatment, yet how effective. Knowing this already I hope it is only necessary to announce my schedule, and the people will come out for examination and treatment in greater numbers than they did before. My treatments during this campaign will be to those where the microscope shows positive infection.

Dr. S. D. Porter the director of the hookworm work in this state came to Franklinton with me, and with the assistance of Mr. Stringfield we made out the following schedule for lectures in the parish.
