Yellow Pine Men Abolish Price List.

St. Louis, Mo., April 8.—The regulation price list of the Yellow Pine Manufacturer's Association no longer will be in vogue, and each member of the association will make individual quotations.

The constitution of the association was so amended to-day at an executive meeting, as to permit open competition in prices. This action, according to Arthur N. Sager, attorney for the association, is in keeping with the pledges made in the Supreme Court by sixteen of the lumber companies ousted and find by the court's decision last December. During the State's inquiry much time was devoted to the uniform price lists compiled by the secretary of the Yellow Pine Manufacturers' Association.

The State contended that there was absolutely no competition in prices, and the scale for lumber was uniform, and each member of the Yellow Pine Association admitted that all sales were made from this particular rating card.

Wards Overcrowded.

Alexandria, La., April 8.—The report of Superintendent Thomas to the Board of Administrators of the Louisiana Hospital for insane submitted to-day showed that there are at present 697 patients in the institution, the largest number ever confined there. The white male wards are overcrowded. The two new buildings which have just been erected were accepted by the board. The new buildings will accommodate 160 patients, but they cannot be occupied until the Legislature appropriates a sufficient sum to furnish them and take care of the inmates.

Keeping \$1,000,000 at Home.

Probably more than \$1,000,000 is being paid annually out of the school funds of Louisiana to teachers brought in from other states. We have no fault to find with such teachers, many of whom have rendered the state excellent service; but we believe that Louisiana men and women should answer the call of the schools and prepare themselves as teachers in such numbers that it will not be necessary, to continue importing teachers. Let this million dollars remain in Louisiana. Young men and young women, go to the State Normal School at Natchitoches where experts are employed by the State for the sole purpose of training teachers, and there prepare yourselves for this important work. Exclusive of books, the necessary expenses for the six weeks' summer school are only \$24, for the ten weeks' school, \$38.
