

SCHOOL BOARD PROCEEDINGS.

Resolution by Mr. Ado Miller, seconded by Mr. C. J. Pullin.

Ordered a special election to be held in Ward Nine, in the Parish of Natchitoches, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said Ward Nine the question of the levy of a special tax of five mills for the purpose of providing additional aid to the public schools of said Ward Nine.

SECTION 1. Be it ordained by the Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, That a special election be, and is hereby ordered to be held in Ward Nine in the Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, on Tuesday the 17th day of August, 1915, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of said Ward Nine the question of the levy of a special tax of five mills on the dollar on all property in said Ward Nine subject to State taxation, for a period of five years, the proceeds of the said tax to be used in building and giving additional aid to the public schools of said Ward Nine.

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained, etc., That the ballots to be used at the said election shall be prepared by the secretary of the Parish Board of School Directors, and shall be in the following form:

Proposition to levy a five mills special tax on all the property subject to taxation in Ward Nine, Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, annually for the period of five years for the purpose of building and giving additional aid to the public schools of said Ward Nine.	YES

NOTICE TO VOTERS: To vote in favor of this proposition place a cross (X) mark under the word "YES," and to vote against same place a similar mark under the word "NO."

SECTION 3. Be it further ordained, etc., That the Secretary of the Parish Board of School Directors be, and he is hereby ordered to cause to be prepared for use at the said election the tally sheets, lists of qualified electors, assessed valuation of property, blank statements for the compilation of the vote, in number and amount and other election blanks that may be required for the purpose

of holding the said election, to cause the same to be placed in the ballot boxes for use at the precincts, and make provisions for the transmission of the ballot boxes to the precincts, of Ward Nine at which the election is to be held.

SECTION 4. Be it further ordained, etc., That the polling places or precincts for said election shall be Natchez and Cypress and the following commissioners and clerks of election are appointed as follows:

Natchez, Leon Friedman, James Nolly and Paul Rachal, commissioners, and Dr. J. B. Pratt, clerk.

Cypress, M. J. Payne, Hyman Jaffa and Jim Salter, commissioners, and B. D. Raines, clerk, all of whom shall serve without compensation.

SECTION 5. Be it further ordained, etc., That the Parish Board of School Directors shall meet at 10 o'clock, a. m., on the 20th day of August, 1915, for the purpose, in open session, of examining and counting the ballots, canvassing the returns and declaring the result of the said election.

SECTION 6. Be it further ordained, etc., That the President of the Parish Board of School Directors be and he is hereby instructed to give public notice of the said election by proclamation to be published according to law in the following form:

PROCLAMATION.

Pursuant to a resolution passed by the Parish Board of School Directors of the Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, at its regular meeting held on the 6th day of July, 1915, I, Edgar Levy, President of said Parish Board of School Directors, hereby give notice that, in compliance with said resolution, a special election will be held in Ward Nine, Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, on Tuesday the 17th day of August, 1915, for the purpose of submitting to the property taxpayers qualified under the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana to vote at said election, the following proposition, to-wit: To levy a special tax of five mills on the dollar on all the property in Ward Nine, Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, subject to State taxation annually for a period of five years, for the purpose of building and giving additional aid to the public schools of Ward Nine.

At said special election the polls will open at seven o'clock, a. m., and close at five o'clock, p. m., and the election will be conducted in accordance with the laws of Louisiana applicable thereto.

Notice is also given that at ten o'clock, a. m., on the 20th day of August, 1915, the said Parish Board of School Directors of the Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, will meet and in open session proceed to open ballot boxes, examine and count the ballots in number and amount, examine and canvass the returns, and declare the result of said special election.
