

#### School Board Proceedings.

Resolution by Mr. M. Barron, seconded by Mr. J. Pullin:

Ordering a special election to be held in Ward 10 addition to the New Prospect School District in the Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the said school district the question of the levy of a special tax of ten mills for the purpose of providing additional aid to the public schools of the said school district.

Section 1. Be it further ordained, that the polling place or precinct for said election shall be Little Rock School House and the following commissioners and clerks of election are appointed as follows: W. H. Jones, A. Troquille, Oscar Couteau, Napoleon Basco, Jr., and Morris Basco, all of whom will serve without compensation.

Section 2. Be it further ordained, that the Parish Board of School Directors shall meet at ten o'clock A. M. on the 15th day of November, 1915, for the purpose, in open session, of examining and counting the ballots, canvassing the returns and declaring the result of the said election.

Section 3. Be it further ordained, that the President of the Parish Board of School Directors be, and he is hereby instructed to give public notice of the said election by proclamation to be duly published, according to law, in the following form:

Section 4. Be it further ordained, that the Secretary of the Parish Board of School Directors be, and he is hereby ordered to cause to be prepared for use at the said election the tally sheets, lists of qualified electors, assessed valuation of property, blank statements for the compilation of the vote, in number and amount, and other

election blanks that may be required for the purpose of holding the said election, to cause the same to be placed in the ballot boxes for use at the precincts, and make provision for the transmission of the ballot boxes to the precincts of the school district at which the election is to be held.

Section 5. Be it further ordained, that the Parish Board of School Directors shall meet at ten o'clock A. M. on the 15th day of November, 1915, for the purpose, in open session, of examining and counting the ballots, canvassing the returns and declaring the result of the said election.

Section 6. Be it further ordained, that the President of the Parish Board of School Directors be, and he is hereby instructed to give public notice of the said election by proclamation to be duly published, according to law, in the following form:

Be it further ordained, that the Parish Board of School Directors of the Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, at its regular meeting held on the 4th day of October, 1915, I, Edgar Levy, President, of said Parish Board of School Directors, hereby give notice that, in compliance with said resolution, a special election will be held in the Ward Ten addition of the New Prospect School District, Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, on Friday the 12th day of November, 1915, for the purpose of submitting to the property taxpayers qualified under the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana to vote at said election, the following proposition, to-wit:

To levy a special tax of ten mills on the dollar on all the property in the Ward Ten addition of the New Prospect School District, Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, subject to State taxation, annually, for a period of three (3) years, for the purpose of building and giving additional aid to the public schools of said sch. of district.

Section 8. Be it further ordained, that the Parish Board of School Directors shall meet at ten o'clock A. M. on the 15th day of November, 1915, for the purpose, in open session, of examining and counting the ballots, canvassing the returns and declaring the result of the said election.

Pursuant to a resolution passed by the Parish Board of School Directors of the Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, at its regular meeting held on the 4th day of October, 1915, I, Edgar Levy, President of said Parish Board of School Directors, hereby give notice that, in compliance with said resolution a special election will be held in Chopin School District, Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, on Friday the 12th day of November, 1915, for the purpose of submitting to the property taxpayers qualified under the constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana to vote at said election, the following proposition, to-wit:

To levy a special tax of five mills on the dollar on all the property in Chopin

School District, Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, subject to state taxation, annually, for a period of five years, for the purpose of building and maintaining the public schools of said school district.

For the purpose of said special election the polling place will be at Chopin, Louisiana, and the following commissioners and clerks of election have been appointed to serve at this election, all of whom will serve without compensation: Lee Sharpe, Alfred Carnahan, M. B. Mayo and M. L. DeLacerda.

At said special election the polls will open at seven o'clock A. M. and close at five o'clock P. M. and the election will be conducted in accordance with the laws of Louisiana applicable thereto.

Notice is also given that at ten o'clock A. M. on the 15th day of November, 1915, the said Parish Board of Directors of the Parish of Natchitoches, Louisiana, will meet at Natchitoches, Louisiana, and in open session proceed to open the ballot boxes, examine and count the ballots in number and amount and canvass the returns and declare the result of said special election.
