### SECOND CYCLONE.

Morgan City was struck on Monday forenoon by a cyclone which shook things up considerably for a brief while. This is the second wind storm, to visit that city, in just six days. This is a record worthy of the best town in Kansas.

The news reached this place about two hours after the happening, and caused considerable uneasiness about the safety of friends and members of families who were in Morgan City at the time. For a while it was difficult to get a message through, but it was learned that a thoroughbred Kansas cyclone passed over Berwick and Morgan City at 9:30 o'clock that morning, playing havoc with property, killing a negro named Escott Wallace and injuring from twelve to fifteen people, among whom are several children and women.

The path of about one hundred and fifty feet was strewn with wreckage. Buildings in the wake of the terrifying whirlwind crumbled one after another, and the escape of people in that section of city is nothing short of miraculous.

An Italian store, in which his family lived in the rear, was crushed to the ground and groceries buried three hundred feet. A girl and her mother were badly injured there.

The residence of Fred. Tessero was completely demolished; five women in the house were unharmed. Several smaller houses went down; others were set out of line.

Brownell, Drew's Lumber Co.'s abingie sheds were badly damaged. The roof of a stable of that company was carried away, leaving twenty mules and horses unharmed.

The residence of Mr. Pissani was out in two and one section carried fifty feet. None of the occupants were injured. The cyclone continued northeastward, and was reported that forenoon as having passed through both Patterson and Centreville, but it seems to have lost its destroying power before reaching the last named places.



### DEMOCRATIC PRIMARIES.

January 25th, 1916, is the date that has been fixed for the Democratic primaries for this state. Candidates for all State offices must qualify by the 25th instant. These are among the results attained at a meeting of the Democratic State Central Committee, held at the Cosmopolitan Hotel in New Orleans on Tuesday.

John W. Lewis, of Opelousas, and Robert E. Butler of Houma, went to New Orleans to urge the convention proposition. They believed a convention important, they said, because of the threatening power of the Progressives. A set of resolutions has been prepared by them for submission to the control committee, but were never presented.

### TICK ERADICATION.

Washington, D C - Nine thousand three hundred and six square miles of territory in Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia and South Carolina will be freed from quarantine for cattle tick on September 15, by an order just signed by the Secretary of Agriculture. The territory freed are those in which the counties, the State and the Department of Agriculture, working in cooperation, have eradicated the tick which causes Texas fever by systematic dipping of cattle in an arsenical bath. The territory just released makes a total territory of 262,469 square miles freed from the tick since 1906 when systematic work to get rid of this cattle pest was undertaken. As the original territory under quarantine for the cattle tick was 741,515 square miles, more than one third of the territory infested has been cleaned.
