ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE No. 357. The following appropriation ordinance was offered and ordered published by Mr. Broussard:

An ordinance entitled the Annual Appropriation Ordinance levying an annual tax of 10 mills on the dollar on the assessed valuation of property in the City of New Iberia...

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of New Iberia, that in order to provide for the payment of the General Expenses of the City Government...

Also to levy a special tax of 1.5 mills on the dollar on all taxable property within the limits of the First Sewerage District...

Be it further ordained, that the said tax as well as the special taxes already mentioned be paid in current money of the United States of America.


City Hall Janitor, \$25.00 per month. City Bridge Keeper, \$30.00 per mo. (Free house rent, water & lights)

Light & Water Department: Chief Engineer, \$150.00 per month. 1st. Ass't Engineer, \$100.00 per mo. 2nd. Ass't Engineer, \$100.00 per mo. 3 Firemen @ \$70.00 per month. Lineman, \$100.00 per month. Pipeman, \$3.00 per day. Helper on lines & Plant, \$2.50 per day.

Any salaries in conflict with the foregoing are hereby repealed. Mr. Upton request the Board of Trustees to have cement sidewalk curb constructed on his property when the sidewalks are constructed, as published originally believing that the curb is necessary.

Fastest Pursuit Plane in World Gives America War Mastery of Sky

The test performance of a new Curtiss Pursuit Plane has caused a sensation in the Army and Navy services. Ever since the Pulitzer Race at Detroit, in which a new all-American motor finished in the first four places, it has been expected that military planes of a super-type would make their appearance at almost any time.

In many respects, this aeroplane is a departure from precedent. It uses the same Curtiss motor used in the racing ships at Detroit. It is equipped with wing radiators, the most radical advance in the art of cooling a motor since 1917, and which reduces the resistance of the air almost to zero.
