A PUBLIC WORK COMPLETED.

From an interview with Mr. Geo. Broughton, President of the Belle Place Drainage District, we are enabled to give our readers some idea of the important work done by this Board. The Drainage Canal starts at the lower line of John M. Henshaw's property on the East side of the Bayou Teche and from thence to Lake Fausse Pointe, an arm of Grand Lake, a distance of seven miles, traversing through the woods and swamps about three and one half miles to the rear of the plantations of Fausse Pointe. A canal the entire length has been cut with an average width of thirty feet at the upper end and ten feet at the upper end or Henshaw's line. There is yet one or two small blocks to be cut out, when the canal will be completed. This is an enterprise long needed by the landowners of Fausse Pointe, and already the good results can be seen in the rapidity with which heavy flood rains disappear, leaving the lands dry. Heretofore there was no outlet and the rear lands were practically useless and could be entered only after extended droughts. It is predicted that in five years these low lands will be cultivated in cane, corn and other crops, enhancing the value of these lands 500 per cent.

Most of the work has been paid for from the revenues of the Board derived from an acreage tax of 10c per acre. There is in striking contrast to the dilatory tactics and discussions of the other drainage districts which have accomplished nothing.
