THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

Due to the presence of much lawlessness in our midst, and the defying of our police officers by disturbers of the peace, thereby escaping arrest, a petition was signed last Wednesday by some thirty of our leading business men requesting the Mayor to call an immediate meeting of the Council to consider the matter.

The Mayor promptly called the meeting, which was largely attended by the citizens of the city and upon invitation of the Council, several expressed themselves on the situation. Hon. Walter J. Burke, Messrs. J. P. Suberbielle, R. S. McMahon and others, appealing to the Council for a more efficient police service in the suppression of the lawless element in our city.

The action of the Council was no doubt right in its vote of censure, and eminently proper, but it went to the other extreme in entirely exonerating the city Judge, and giving him a vote of confidence for, it is well known that the city Judge is not blameless. But a short time ago one of our officers was assaulted in the presence of this Judge, and even he was threatened if he interfered, this information was furnished us by the Judge himself.

Judge Brown must bear his share of the responsibility for the non-respect accorded our police, as he did not on the occasions above mentioned properly support them, his action would have a tendency to bring their authority into contempt. That a mistake was made by the Mayor he himself admits, and we think the Council did right in their censure, but at the same time we think the city Judge was not altogether blameless.
