### DEBT IS ON THE OTHER SIDE.

"There is no question but that a very large majority of the people favor 'Cuban reciprocity' as proposed by the majority of the ways and means committee, and erroneously termed 'the president's policy,'" said Representative Eddy of Minnesota to-day: "Although I do not agree with the public in this matter, any other statement would be a perversion of facts. The public is of the opinion that we owe something to Cuba," that this proposition would benefit the Cuban planter, that it is inimical to the interests of the sugar trust and that it originated with the president. Holding these opinions, the people, following the lead of certain papers, have dubbed those who opposed the scheme 'insurgents,' and think their opposition is based either upon corrupt motives or through ignorance. Public opinion is generally right and, as a rule, it is safer for a legislator to follow the well considered opinion of a majority of his fellow citizens than that of the wisest statesman. Sometimes, however, such opinion is based on passion, mistake or sentiment, and when such is the case it goes wrong and awfully wrong, and when a legislator believes this to be true and bows to the blast instead of resolutely performing what he believes to be his duty and earnestly endeavoring to correctly point out the errors on which such opinion is formed and patiently waiting for time to vindicate him, he is unworthy to represent any constituency.

### IMPORTING STRUCTURAL STEEL.

It is given out that for a long time the American manufacturers have been unable to supply the demand for structural steel, and that it is being imported from Europe for numerous large buildings that are in course of being erected.

According to reports, officials of the Steel Trust account for the situation by saying that the shortage is due to a lack of coal and a scarcity of coke caused by the congestion in the freight traffic and the fact that coal used in making coke is being sold in the open market to consumers. When, however, the independent manufacturers are questioned, they say that the Steel Trust is only keeping up the prices of steel billets, so that the outsiders who manufacture the structural beams and posts, but do not make steel and have to buy the billets, cannot do the work at present prices of billets.

It is true, it is a dog-in-the-manger policy which allows foreigners to come into our market and undersell our manufacturers. But then everything is for the benefit of the trusts, not even excepting the Government itself.


