NEW FLYING MACHINE. WHEN WOMEN ENVY MEN.

New York, July 20.—With a machine weighing twenty-six pounds, and consisting of two sets of wings, each wing ten feet in length, with four wheels to operate them, John Holland, inventor of the submarine boat, believes he has solved the problem of aerial navigation without the aid of ballast or gasbags, and will make flying safer and more popular than bicycle riding ever was.

The machine has been building since last December at machine shop of George White, Jersey City. White is an experienced machinist, who did much of the work in submarine boats. The device is now complete save for the wings.

Mr. Holland visited the machine shop to-day for a final inspection of the completed flying machine before having it boxed and shipped to his home in Newark. It is so compact that it can be carried in a large-sized trunk.

All its parts save the wires that operate the wings are of aluminum. The wires are of the finest quality of steel. Experiments are now being made with various materials in an effort to construct a framework for the wings which will be light and still strong enough to bear the tremendous strain which will be put upon them. With these wings complete the machine will be ready for testing within a few weeks.

The test will be made by Mr. Holland, who has supreme faith in his ability to fly at the first venture.

Mr. White believes with Mr. Holland's machine just completed the problem of aerial navigation by the individual has been solved.

The Holland flying machine is built on the line of the bird; not, however, on the old theory that a bird lifts its weight by beating its wings, but on the aeroplane principle.

"There is not power enough in the wings of a bird," said Mr. Holland to-day, "to lift one twentieth of its weight. The wings are only used for propulsion and to start the bird in its flight or to retard its progress when it desires to alight. A man has power enough in his legs and arms to accomplish all that the bird does, providing he is supplied with the requisite aeroplanes and the means of operating them as propellers. Once in motion it is merely a matter of moderate exertion to fly.

"With less energy than it takes to walk three miles an hour a man can fly twenty miles an hour, there is enough muscular energy in the human being to travel at the rate of fifty miles an hour through the air. The greatest exertion will be in getting the machine in motion, when a rapid beating of the wings is necessary, and in alighting, when the position of the wings and aeroplanes must be shifted so as to beat against the air and stay aloft.

"I will have no hesitation in using my flying machine. It is much safer than a bicycle. I know that in the air I will be perfectly safe, yet I have never yet had nerve enough to mount a bicycle and take the risk of headers and collisions."—Times Democrat.
