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**A Stray Wireless Message.**

A peculiar phenomena occurred in New Orleans some days ago which indicates the remarkable length which wireless messages may travel. On the roof of the tall skyscraper of the Iberia Bank & Trust Co. is erected an apparatus for sending and receiving wireless messages to Galveston, Key West, Tampa, Mobile and eventually to Panama. The operator in charge was startled with a faint message, which he finally deciphered to be one from some vessel far off in the ocean and presumably in the North Atlantic for it told of encountering and then being in a great snow storm. The message was intended evidently for New York, but the sound waves traveling through space, were caught by the sensitive receiver of the New Orleans Station fairly intelligibly. Whether or not the message was wholly deflected from its true course has not been discovered.

**More Tulane Scholarships.**

The growth and expansion of Tulane University, Louisiana's great educational institution, has been very marked during recent years and the number of free scholarships has been increased to 116 out of a total Academic Scholarship of 238. In order to provide more adequately for expenses of these free scholarships, which are distributed all over the state, a fund is being raised in New Orleans, and other sections of Louisiana. Friends of Tulane claim that a fund of \$15,000 a year, a portion of which has already been secured, would remove the necessity for the annual struggle to make ends meet, and would thereby benefit the institution immensely. Public spirited men of New Orleans are taking great interest in the movement and leading men in the parishes are doing likewise. Tulane Alumni are taking active charge of the campaign.
