U. S. RAILROAD ACCIDENTS.

Washington, D. C., July 28.—Accident bulletin No. 15, just issued by the interstate commerce commission, giving an account of railroad accidents in the United States during the months of January, February and March, 1905, shows that during that quarter there were 28 passengers and 204 employees killed and 1,651 passengers and 2,062 employees injured in accidents. Other accidents to passengers and employees not the result of collisions or derailments bring the total number of casualties up to 15,306 (909 killed and 14,397 injured.)

There was a decrease of 42 in the total number of persons killed as compared with the quarter ending December 31, 1904. The total number of employees reported killed in coupling and uncoupling during this quarter was 62.

The greatest blow that cattle interests of Texas have ever suffered will be the placing on the market of six million acres of public land owned by the state on September 15th. These lands have been under lease to cattlemen for many years. It was announced by the State Land Commissioner that the six million acres would be sold to actual settlers in tracts of one to eight sections each. The price fixed is \$1 per acre, payable in forty annual installments, with three per cent interest. Every purchaser must live upon the land for three years to acquire title. After the sale of this land the state will still own twelve million acres, which are under lease to cattlemen.
