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**BUDGET FOR 1915.**  
 An ordinance adopting a budget of the estimated required to pay the expenses of conducting the business of the City Government of the City of New Iberia, for the ensuing fiscal year ending December 31st, 1915, showing the aggregate sum and the items thereof allowed to each Department office, Board or Commission, stating the amounts required to meet the interest and maturing bond, of the outstanding indebtedness of the City and the warrants of all Departments of the Municipal Government in detail, and showing specifically the amount necessary to be provided for each fund and department, also an estimate of the amount of income from fines, licenses, water and light rents and all other sources of revenue, exclusive of taxes upon property and the probable amount required to be levied and raised by taxation to defray all expenses and liabilities of the City, as a basis for the purpose, at the proper time, of levying an annual tax in order to provide a revenue for the fiscal year ending December 31st, 1915. Also three mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the City of New Iberia, to pay the annual interest and a portion of the principal due on the Light and Water Bonds. Also a special tax of three mills on the dollar on all taxable property within the City of New Iberia, to pay the annual interest and a portion of the principal of the debts contracted by the New Iberia Southern Drainage Canal. And also a special tax of three and one half mills on the dollar, on all taxable property within the City of New Iberia, to aid of the New Iberia and Northern Railroad Company and a tax of two mills on the dollar on all taxable property within the City of New Iberia, in aid of the Southwestern Traction and Power Company, as voted by the property taxpayers within the City of New Iberia. The present ordinance was presented to the Board of Trustees of the City of New Iberia by J. P. Suberbielle, Trustee of Finance and after examination and mature deliberation, the sum was approved as follows: Messrs. Alpha Fontelleu, J. P. Suberbielle, and I. A. Villiermin. Nay, none. Therefore, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the City of New Iberia, that the same be duly published as the law requires, and that it be inserted in the minute and ordinance books of the City according to the law.
