

PROCEEDINGS OF POLICE JURY.

(Continued From Page 1.) This Police Jury hereby recognizes the urgent need of the Parish and various public bodies therein for a map such as is provided for and to be made under said above contract, as well as for the said township maps and land entries; the proper estimating of the timber resources of this Parish and the verification of said map and work, and it further declares said undertaking, maps, documents, reports and data to be furnished under said contract, a work of great necessity and public benefit, and that same will be serviceable in many ways, including the organizing of road districts, maintaining and construction of public roads, the maintaining of drains, the construction of new drains, the outlining and defining of drainage and sub-drainage districts, the hooping and determining possible complaints, when sitting as a Board of Reviewers, and that it would be of great public benefit in many other ways as well.

Jury as to the correctness, efficiency and completeness of same, with the view to the said Police Jury making partial payments as stipulated therein; it being the duty of said Committee to supervise said work and to report to the said Police Jury all errors, inaccuracies or incompleteness or failure in performance of said contract by said Kemper or his estate and heirs, as the case may be.
