

LIMITS SHERIFF'S INCOME TO \$3,600.

Senator Schwing's Proposed Legislation Does Not Eliminate Fee System.

Baton Rouge, La., May 10.—Senator Charles E. Schwing's sheriff's compensation bill, presented Wednesday in the Senate and the first measure to be offered in the upper chamber, does not eliminate sheriffs' fees and fix a flat salary rate for those officials, but it provides that no sheriff's income shall exceed \$3,600 a year.

The legislators who believe that Louisiana's sheriffs are overpaid, realize that in several of the parishes the income of the sheriffs does not amount to \$3,600 a year, so the bill which Senator Schwing has drafted provides that sheriffs shall receive up to \$3,600 a year, five per cent of the first \$50,000 in license collected by them, and one-fourth per cent of subsequent collections.

Limits Number of Deputies.

Senator Schwing's bill limits the number of deputy sheriffs to "not less than one, nor more than three." It stipulates, however, that in cases of emergency or where special work is to be done the district judges, upon application of the sheriffs, may appoint additional deputies whose salaries are to be paid by the police jury or governing body of the parish.

The first deputy sheriff's salary is fixed by the bill at \$1,200 a year; the second at \$900; the third at \$600 and the special deputies are to be paid not more than \$2 a day "for the time actually served."

"The police jury or other parish governing body shall be the judge of the necessity of continuing special deputies in the service," says the bill.

The fees and salaries which the bill provides are to be paid from the tax and license collections. If the three deputies include a jailor, who shall likewise be designated as a deputy sheriff by the sheriff, he shall be paid by the police jury or similar body and his salary shall be not less than \$600, nor more than \$1,200 a year.

Does Not Restrict Appointments.

"The sheriffs, in receiving authority to appoint additional deputies," the bill continues, "shall be entirely free to appoint whomsoever they choose, being entirely responsible for the acts of their deputies."

Before the expense of keeping and feeding prisoners in the parish jails and transferring to State institution, prisoners, insane persons, juveniles, lepers, be paid they shall be examined by the governing body of the parish and by the State supervisor of public accounts.

"A full and complete account of all moneys taken in from whatever source," shall be kept by each sheriff, separate records for seizures, sales and tax deeds shall be kept, and the sheriffs "shall not be allowed to charge for any service not actually made, nor for mileage not actually traveled."

The sheriff of course, shall be recompensed for advertising in accordance with the legal rate and for costs of seizures, sales and sheriffs' deeds, provided his income does not exceed \$3,600 per annum.

All sheriffs' records shall be subject at any time to investigation by the parochial governing body or the supervisor of public accounts or any taxpayer, "and shall in fact be public records subject to the inspection, investigation and examination of the public."

Four bills limiting the incomes of sheriffs, assessors and clerks of courts, requiring those officers to keep itemized records of their receipt and expenditures were introduced in the Senate Wednesday by Senator Schwing of Iberia. They were the first measures to be presented to the senate.
