IF ROOSEVELT DECLINES TO RUN AND SUPPORTS JUSTICE HUGHES IT WILL BE SOME 'HOSS' RACE SAYS CLARK.

Washington, June 11.—Speaker Champ Clark issued a statement today criticizing the republicans for selecting a justice of the supreme court as candidate for the presidency and the progressives for nominating Colonel Roosevelt, "in violation of the two-term rule."

"If Colonel Roosevelt accepts the nomination of the bull moosers, Woodrow Wilson will win in a walk," said the speaker. "If Colonel Roosevelt declines the nomination and supports Mr. Justice Hughes, it will be what my Kentucky friends call a 'hoss' race, with the odds very much in favor of Woodrow Wilson."

"Some philosophers claim there's nothing in luck. President Wilson's career should confound them utterly. The regular republicans and the bull moosers might have agreed on some man of ability who would not have been confronted with the wise and wholesome precedents of more than a century."
