## LOUISIANA 20,000 SHORT OF ESTIMATE.

Baton Rouge, June 12.—With a total estimated registration of 157,827 men between the ages of 21 and 31 as against 171,000 as estimated for Louisiana by the War Department through the census bureau, it is seen that the state fell short of expectations by nearly 20,000.  
 The total white registration as indicated by the reports to the Governor compiled by the adjutant general's office is 88,110 with a total exemption or indicated exemption of 56,923. The total negro registration is 66,535, with an exemption indicated of 37,530. Alien friends number 2,966 in the state while 216 are classified as alien enemies.

The cause of Louisiana's falling below the War Department's estimation is probably due to the fact that it was based on the census of 1910. The entrance of the boll weevil in many of the cotton parishes has caused a considerable loss in population in those parishes since that time.

## FREE SPEECH AND TREASON.

Two classes of men with entirely different viewpoints are in evidence in the Congress and in the positions of great prominence in the Government service. One set of men declare in favor of open and free discussion of all public questions arising out of the war, and maintain that free speech and liberty are the same thing. Another class would absolutely forbid any criticism of the policy and plans of the Government, and would place the charge of treason against any person who openly criticised the Government, its Executives, or the methods of either. Between these two radical views there

doubtless exists a middle ground which will make it entirely proper for anyone to express their views upon public questions in a temperate manner. Censorship, and the suppression of public meetings and free speech, are harsh measures; but it is not probable that American ideals in reference to these problems will be overlooked or changed very much.—Houma Times.
