The following ordinance offered by Mr. Derouen, seconded by Mr. Romero, and adopted to-wit: An Ordinance levying a tax to pay the principal and interest due on the bond issue of Forty Seven Thousand Dollars, dated August 1st, 1919 of Road District Number Eight of Iberia Parish.

Be it Ordained by the Police Jury of the Parish of Iberia acting as governing authority of Road District No. Eight of the Parish of Iberia, that the Assessor and Tax Collector of the Parish of Iberia be and are hereby instructed and ordered to assess and collect a tax of Three (3) Mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within Road District No. Eight of the Parish of Iberia for the year 1919, to pay the principal and interest on the bond issue of said Road District amounting to Three Thousand Three Hundred Fifty Dollars dated February and August 1920 and that a copy of this ordinance be forwarded to both the Assessor and the Tax Collector of the Parish of Iberia, as their authority to assess and collect said tax.

Be it further ordained that ordinances or part of ordinances contrary to or in conflict with this Ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
