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TABASCO SAUCE DAMAGE SUIT.

With application for an injunction restraining B. F. Trappey & Sons, of Jeanerette, from using the name "Tabasco" and from imitating their bottles and labels in manufacturing pepper sauce the Mellhenny company of Iberia parish brought back to life an old fight in the United States court Wednesday.

The petition filed for the Avery Island originators of Tabasco sauce by a syndicate of the city's best legal talent—John S. Clark, Esmond Phelps, Charles Payne Fenner, Walter B. Spencer and Philip Gidiere—also asks more than \$3000 damages from the Jeanerette concern.

It recites that since 1911 the Trappey brothers have been making a pepper sauce and labeling it with the patented name of the Mellhenny sauce. A similar suit was fought in the United States court by the Mellhenny company several years ago.

For 50 years, the Mellhenny company have been building up the name of Tabasco sauce. They charge the Trappeys with infringing on their property rights in appropriating the name "Tabasco" for their pepper sauce.—Item.
