Extract from the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Iberia Parish School Board held on October 2 1919.

New Iberia, La., Oct. 2, 1919. The regular meeting of the Iberia Parish School Board was held this date at the office of the Board in the Masonic Temple as per due notice mailed to each member.

There were the following members present: President J. E. Verret, presiding; Dr. U. S. Perret, Messrs. George Winters, Louis Grand, Gus Bonin, Jr., H. T. Hall and H. R. Minvielle.

There were the following members absent: Messrs. Albin Segura, Eugene Guillot, Telesphore Robichaux and E. P. Moresi.

The President announced the presence of a quorum and the opening of the meeting for the transaction of business.

It was moved by Mr. Hall, seconded by Dr. Perret that the following ordinance be adopted:

AN ORDINANCE

ordering a special election in School District Number Six, Iberia Parish, La., as created by resolution of the Iberia Parish School Board of date January 3, 1914, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the said School District the question of a bond issue of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) the proceeds of the said bond issue to be used to erect and equip a school building or school buildings in the said School District.

Whereas it is necessary and desirable that funds be raised for the purpose of erecting and equipping a school building or school buildings in School District No. Six, Iberia Parish, Louisiana, and

Whereas it is the voluntary will of this body to call the election hereinafter provided for, and

Whereas Article 281 of the Constitution of Louisiana and Act 256 of the Legislature of 1910 as amended by Act 216 of 1912 declare the Iberia Parish School Board to be the governing authority through which the said School District may incur debt and issue negotiable bonds for such purposes when so authorized at an election to be held in the said School District, and

Whereas the assessed valuation of the said District for the year 1919 as per abstract of assessment filed with the State Board of Affairs (on one hundred per cent. basis) amounts to Six Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty Two Dollars, (\$6,260,862.00) and there being no bonded indebtedness incurred under Article 281 of the Constitution of Louisiana, the total proposed indebtedness does not exceed the Constitutional limit of ten per cent. of the assessed valuation, and

Whereas the special tax necessary to be annually levied to extinguish the proposed indebtedness will approximate two and one-quarter mills, which said millage will not exceed the Constitutional limit of ten mills per annum on the dollar of assessed valuation of the property of said District, now therefore

Sec. 1. Be it ordained by the Iberia Parish School Board in lawful session convened, that an election shall be and is hereby called to be held in the said School District Number Six in the Parish of Iberia, Louisiana on the 18th day of November, 1919 at which election the majority of the property taxpayers of the said District in number and amount, eligible to vote and voting shall determine the

Proposition to incur debt and issue bonds of the said School District Number Six, Iberia Parish, Louisiana, to the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) to run for a period of thirty years, bearing interest at the rate of five per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually, the funds thus derived to be used for the purpose of erecting and equipping a school building or school buildings in said School District Number Six, Iberia Parish, Louisiana.

To be held on November 18th, 1919, in accordance with a resolution passed by the Iberia Parish School Board on October 2, 1919.

BALLOT.

Proposition to incur debt and issue bonds of School District No. Six, in the Parish of Iberia, Louisiana to the amount of two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) to run for a period of thirty (30) years, bearing interest at the rate of five per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually for the purpose of erecting and equipping a school building or school buildings in School District Number Six, Parish of Iberia, Louisiana.

Taxable valuation \$..... Signature of Voter..... Signature of Voter's Agents casting ballot by proxy..... Notice to Voters—To vote in favor of the proposition submitted on this ballot, place a cross (X) in the square after the word "Yes", and to vote against it, place a similar mark after the word "No."

(Note.—Commissioners may fill blanks on face of ticket, but voter must sign on back of ticket.)

Sec. 3. Be it further ordained, etc., that the commissioners and clerks of election at said election shall serve without compensation, and the said election shall be held at the following polling places or precincts:

Precinct No. 1, Court House; Precinct No. 2, Fire House No. 1; Precinct No. 3, Fire House No. 2; Precinct No. 4, Goodwin's Hospital.

And the following persons shall serve as commissioners and clerks of the said election as provided by law:

Precinct No. 1.—Pierre Jubin, Ozeme Jacob, Fred Patout, Commissioners; George Cousin, Clerk. Precinct No. 2.—Harry Winters, L. O. Haeker, Henry Patout, Commissioners; Louis Bazus, Clerk.

Precinct No. 3.—J. D. Broussard, E. M. Boutte, A. Daigre, Commissioners; Charles Guillot, Clerk.

Precinct No. 4.—Clarence Duperier, Robert Landry, F. J. Dauterive, Commissioners; C. M. Bahon, Jr., Clerk.

Sec. 4. Be it further ordained, etc., that notice of this election containing the proposition herein submitted to the voters shall be prepared and signed by the President and Secretary of the Iberia Parish School Board, and shall be published by the Secretary in the Weekly Iberian which are constituted the official journals for the publication of the said proceedings by four weekly insertions, the date of the first insertion to be as many as thirty (30) days before the date of the election.

The said notice shall further recite that on the 19th day of November, 1919, the first day following such election at 11 o'clock A. M. the Iberia Parish School Board will meet at the office of the said Board, in said Parish, and there in public session open the ballot boxes, examine and canvass the returns and declare the result of said election, and promulgate the same.

The motion being put to a vote was unanimously carried, and the President declared the ordinance adopted.

On motion of Dr. U. S. Perret, seconded by Mr. H. R. Minvielle, a committee composed of the President, J. E. Verret; the superintendent, L. R. Tilly, and Messrs. H. T. Hall and Eugene Guillot, members of the Board from the Sixth Ward was appointed with power to take all such preliminary steps before the holding of the said election as might be necessary to carry through the said project, and in the event the election carried to take all such steps as in their opinion might be expedient or necessary in all matters pertaining to the erecting and equipping of the said school or schools, provided for in the foregoing resolution, the said committee being fully em-

powered to act in the premises for the Board in all matters pertaining to the said project as fully and completely as the Board could in the premises under the law.

The motion being put to a vote was unanimously carried, and the president declared the motion adopted.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, on motion of Mr. Grand, seconded by Mr. Bonin the meeting adjourned.
