AMERICAN COTTON ASS'N.

At a meeting of the State Committee of the Louisiana Division of the American Cotton Association held May 7th, two committees were provided for to look into legislation in the interest of the cotton industry. One committee, composed of Harry D. Wilson, Paul D. Perkins of Calcasieu; N. C. Williamson of East Carroll; W. H. Hodges, Jr. of Shreveport; Grundy Cooper of Rapides and W. B. Thompson of Orleans, will confine its effort to legislation concerning the pink boll worm infestation in Southwest Louisiana. Information given the committee by Mr. Perkins and Mr. Wilson, indicated that the amount of compensation required for the cotton farmers of Cameron will not be as great as at first supposed.

The other committee, to be composed of seven members, will be named later by Chairman Thompson, and will devote its energies towards legislation in the interest of the cotton producer, by endeavoring to realize part of the program of constructive effort of the American Cotton Association. The first question is that of warehousing. Louisiana has a good warehouse law, but in the warehouse program of the association are some features which may require special legislation. The next question is to have a course in cotton grading and stapling established in the State University or Tulane. It may be possible to accomplish this without additional expense, through the operations of the Smith-Huey federal law. Another question is to require the railroads to provide shelter for cotton on railroad platform and in yards. Chairman Thompson was instructed to call a conference with the railroad interests to endeavor to have this done without attempting to force it by legislation.

The plan for a systematic campaign of the state by groups of parishes was endorsed, and in a

few weeks will be put into effect. Charter memberships totaled 322 on April 30th, which is almost one-half of the States quota.

Chairman Thompson was instructed to investigate the advisability of incorporating the state division, or to file the original charter of the national association with the secretary of state; so as to give permanence to the Louisiana Division.

A vote of thanks to the papers of the city and the country for their co-operation in the movement was adopted.
