NEW IBERIA ROAD WORK UNDER WAY.

The Lafayette Gazette says: "Those who have occasion to make an auto trip between Lafayette and New Iberia will hear with much pleasure the news that the only bad spot in the Southern National highway between these two cities is fast being eliminated by the contractors.

Considerable gravel already has been unloaded alongside the road and the work of building bridges and culverts is under way, while the road itself has been torn up and a new roadbed is being built.

When completed this new stretch of highway will bring the two cities twenty minutes closer and offer a continuous stretch of hard-surfaced smooth highway twenty miles long and furnish an ideal motor trip for those who enjoy such diversions.

The contractor figured that it would require a couple of months to complete the work, if favored by normal weather conditions, and it is assured that by September 1 one will be able to glide from Lafayette into New Iberia by auto in about forty minutes without running any risk whatever of being pinched for speeding.

Another Royal Suggestion COOKIES and SMALL CAKES From the NEW ROYAL COOK BOOK

WHEN the children romp, in hungry as young bears, here are some wholesome, economical delights that will not only be received with glee, but will satisfy the most ravenous appetite in a most wholesome manner.

Cookies 1/2 cup shortening 1 cup sugar 1/2 cup milk 1 egg 1/2 teaspoon grated nutmeg 1 teaspoon vanilla extract or grated rind of 1 lemon 4 cups flour 2 teaspoons Royal Baking Powder Cream shortening and sugar together; add milk to beaten eggs and beat again; add slowly to creamed shortening and sugar; add nutmeg and flavoring; add 2 cups flour sifted with baking powder; add enough more flour to make stiff dough. Roll out very thin on floured board; cut with cookie cutter, sprinkle with sugar, or put a raisin or a piece of English walnut in the center of each. Bake about 12 minutes in hot oven.

Cocoa Drop Cakes 4 tablespoons shortening 1 cup sugar 1 egg 1/2 cup milk 1/2 cup flour 1/2 teaspoon Royal Baking Powder 1/2 cup cocoa 1/2 teaspoon salt 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Cream shortening; add sugar and well-beaten egg; beat well and add milk slowly; sift flour, baking powder, salt and cocoa into mixture; stir until smooth, add vanilla. Put one tablespoon of batter into each greased muffin tin and bake in moderate oven about 20 minutes. Cover with boiled icing.

Orange Cakes 4 tablespoons shortening 1 cup sugar 1/2 cup milk 1 egg 2 cups flour 2 teaspoons Royal Baking Powder 1/2 teaspoon salt 1 teaspoon orange extract grated rind of 1 orange Cream shortening; add sugar slowly, beating well; add milk a little at a time; then add well-beaten egg; sift flour, baking powder and salt together and add to mixture; add flavoring and grated orange rind; mix well. Bake in greased shallow tin, or individual cake tins, in hot oven 15 to 20 minutes. When cool cover with orange icing.




Baton Rouge, La., June 9.
