

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE CONSTITUTION OF LOUISIANA

Adopted at the Regular Session of the Legislature of 1920-21. Held at the Capitol Building, Baton Rouge, Louisiana, on the 11th day of November, 1920.

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Louisiana requiring the police jury of each parish of the State and the Orleans Parish School Board, respectively, to levy an annual tax for school purposes...

In addition to all taxes now authorized by the Constitution or by law, there is hereby levied for the year 1921 and each year thereafter, in aid of public education, a tax of one mill on the dollar of assessed valuation of all taxable property within the State of Louisiana, it being hereby required that said tax shall be extended on the tax rolls and collected as all other State taxes.
