New Iberia, La., October 21, 1920.

Gentlemen—By order of the President, a special meeting of the Police Jury of Iberia Parish is hereby called to be held October 21st, 1920 at 10 A. M. for the purpose of

(1) Levying a tax of 5 mills on the dollar of assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Parish of Iberia, Corporations excepted, as required by Act 191 of 1918.

(2) Levying a tax of 2 mills on the dollar of assessed valuation on all property within the Corporate limits of the City of New Iberia, the Town of Jeanerette, the Village of Loreauville, the Village of Delcambre, known as Criminal tax.

(3) Levying a tax of 1 1-2 mill on the dollar of assessed valuation of all the taxable property within the Parish of Iberia, Corporations excepted, in support of the Public Schools as required by Act 218 of 1918.

(4) Levying a tax of 2 mills on the dollar of assessed valuation of all the taxable property within the Parish of Iberia, the City of New Iberia, the Town of Jeanerette, the Villages of Loreauville and Delcambre excepted, to pay bonded indebtedness incurred prior to adoption of the constitutional amendment of November, 1918.

(5) Levying a tax of 2 1-2 mills on the dollar of the assessed valuation of all the taxable property within Road District No. 2, 4 and 6 of Iberia Parish, to pay interests and maturing bonds of its respective road bond issues due in 1921.

(6) Levying a tax of 1 1-2 mill on the dollar of assessed valuation of all taxable property within Road District No. 7 of Iberia Parish, to pay maturing bonds and interests of Road Bond Issue due 1921.

(7) Adopting a license ordinance.

LICENSE ORDINANCE.
An ordinance by the Police Jury of Iberia Parish to levy, collect and enforce payment of an annual license tax upon all person or persons, business firms or corporations pursuing any trade, vocation calling or business within the limits of the Parish of Iberia, State of Louisiana and without the Corporate Limits of the City of New Iberia, the Town of Jeanerette the Village of Loreauville and the Village of Delcambre.

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Police Jury of Iberia Parish that there is hereby levied an annual license tax for the year 1921 upon each person or persons, association of persons, business firms or corporations, pursuing any trade, vocation, calling or business subject to license tax within the Parish of Iberia and without the Corporate limits of the City of New Iberia, the Town of

Jeanerette, the Village of Loreauville, and the Village of Delcambre.
Sec. 2. Be it ordained by the Police Jury of Iberia Parish, that beginning on the First day of January 1921, the tax collector of the Parish of Iberia shall begin to collect and shall collect as fast as possible from each of those enumerated below a license tax as hereinafter graduated:
Sec. 3. Be it further ordained by the Police Jury of Iberia Parish that all licenses shall be due and collected during the first two months of the year 1921 and all unpaid licenses shall become delinquent on the first day of March, 1921 and all firms who commence business after this date shall pay their licenses within ten days following the opening of their business.

Sec. 4. Be it further ordained, etc., that for any person or persons operating a public dance hall, ball room or any other place of amusement where an entrance fee is charged, either directly or indirectly, or where refreshments are sold, shall pay an annual license of Ten Dollars.
Sec. 5. Be it further ordained, etc., that for every business of selling merchandise at retail, whether the business be conducted as principal agent on commission or otherwise, the license shall be as herein fixed and graded to-wit:
(a) When the gross sales are Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars or more and less than Thirty Thousand Dollars, the license shall be Thirty Dollars, (\$30.00).
(b) When the gross sales are Twenty Thousand Dollars or more and less than Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars, the license shall be Twenty-Five Dollars.
(c) When the gross sales are Fifteen Thousand Dollars or more and less than Twenty Thousand Dollars, the license shall be Twenty Dollars, (\$20.00).
(d) When the gross sales are Ten Thousand Dollars or more and less than Fifteen Thousand Dollars the license shall be Fifteen Dollars, (\$15.00).
(e) When the gross sales are Five Thousand Dollars or more and less than Ten Thousand Dollars, the license shall be Ten Dollars, (\$10.00).
(f) When the gross sales are less than Five Thousand Dollars, the license shall be Five Dollars, (\$5.00).

Sec. 6. Be it further ordained, etc., that no museum, menagerie or circus or other traveling show, shall be permitted to make exhibitions within this Parish, unless they have first paid a license based on the number of attaches, whether proprietors, performers or other employees, which license is as follows:
(a) When the number of persons is one hundred or more the license shall be One Hundred Dollars for each performance.
(b) When the number of persons is less than one hundred the license shall be Fifty Dollars, (\$50.00) for each performance.

Sec. 7. Be it further ordained that for each and every peddler or hawker other than vendors of ice shall pay an annual license which license is hereby fixed and graded as follows:
When traveling on foot, Fifty Dollars, (\$50.00).
When traveling on horse back, Sixty Dollars, (\$60.00).

When traveling in a one horse vehicle, Seventy Five Dollars, (\$75.00).
When traveling in a two horse vehicle, motor vehicle or truck, One-Hundred Dollars, (\$100.00).

When traveling in any kind of watercraft, Two Hundred Dollars, (\$200.00).
And provided further that all parochial officers are hereby empowered and directed to cause all peddlers and hawkers to exhibit their Parish license and the said peddler or hawker failing to exhibit the same, the said officers are directed and empowered to seize said stock of merchandise and turn same over to any court of competent jurisdiction, with due information as to the violation of this ordinance.

Sec. 8. Be it further ordained that for every automobile, auto truck, motor cycle or any other self propelling vehicle kept within the Parish of Iberia, and with out the Corporate limits of the City of New Iberia, the Town of Jeanerette, the Village of Loreauville and the Village of Delcambre an annual license is hereby levied as follows:
(a) When the seating capacity is seven or more Seven Dollars, (\$7.00).
(b) When the capacity is five and less than seven, Five Dollars, (\$5.00).
(c) When the seating capacity is two or less than five, Three Dollars, (\$3.00).
(d) For motor truck or freight carrying automobile, Five Dollars, (\$5.00).
(e) For motor cycle, Two Dollars, (\$2.00).

Sec. 9. Be it further ordained that the following trades are subject to an annual license of Five Dollars to-wit: Doctors and transients photographers.
