MORE PARISH REGISTRARS.

The constitutional convention has adopted, in the last stages of its life, an ordinance creating the office of parish registrar of voters. Each parish in the state will have its registrar, and it goes without saying that the work of the office will not be burdensome and in the small parishes will be absolutely insignificant indeed. The work has heretofore been performed by clerk of the district courts ex-officio, who have been paid so much for each voter registered.

Under the terms of the ordinance the police juries of the respective parishes will elect the parish registrar of voters, but after they once choose that official they are powerless to remove him, that duty devolving solely on the shoulders of a board composed of the governor, lieutenant governor and speaker of the lower house of the legislature.
