NOW IS THE TIME FOR PLANNING GARDENS IN LOUISIANA.

Fall gardens can be grown throughout Louisiana, and every person who has land available should have one. The value of gardens with regard to benefit in diet, reduction of food bills and real pleasure is too much underestimated and too little appreciated.

Winter gardens are somewhat restricted to the southern portion of the state. However, in the northern part such hardy vegetables as cabbage, turnips, beets, carrots and the like can be grown in a normal winter.

In planning and planting the fall garden the following points should be kept in mind:
First—Free the ground of weeds and grass before plowing. This is essential. Never plow under any fresh vegetable matter if you wish to plant soon. This material interferes

with the water rising in the soil, which is a very important factor in fall garden work. It also heats and causes the soil to dry out sooner than it normally would. Where fertilizer is necessary use well-rotted manure. This should be applied beneath the ridge during preparation. If the soil is poor it may be necessary to apply some commercial fertilizer. Ordinarily 100 to 150 pounds of a mixture of equal parts of cotton seed meal and high-grade acid phosphate to the tenth acre should give good results.

Second—As the land is already in ridges, 3 1-2 to 4 feet apart, time may be saved in plowing by deepening the furrows between the old ridges with the plow, and then building on this trench to form the new ridge. If, however, the land is quite hard, and this method would not give thorough preparation, or the distance between the ridges needs to be changed, it would be necessary to flat break the plot, harrow and ridge it.

Third—After removing the spring crop, the land should be ridged at once for the fall garden. This will keep the weeds down, and the rains will firm the soil. No seed should be planted until the freshly plowed land has been settled by at least one good rain.

Fourth—On sandy well drained land it may be advisable to use flat culture in making the fall garden. On heavier soil, low flat ridges may be advisable.

South Louisiana.
Start the following in July or early August unless otherwise indicated.

Irish Potatoes—Lookout Mountain, late July; White Star about August 15.

Tomatoes—Late June or early July in rows in the open. Barflana variety.

Pepper—Late June or early July. Sow in rows in the open. Royal King.

Cabbage—Sow in rows in the open. Copenhagen Market, Henderson's Succession and Charleston Wakefield.

Collards—Georgia.
Kohl Rabi—White Vienna. Very desirable. Kohl Rabi milder in taste than turnips:
Brussels Sprouts—Dwarf Long Island.
Okra—White velvet, June or July.

Start the following in August or September unless otherwise indicated:

Turnips—Purple Top Globe or White Egg.

Beets—Crosby's Egyptian.
Carrots—Danver's Half Long, Chantenay.

Radish—Chartier, Crimson Giant, White Icicle.

Spinach—Broomsdale. Late September or October.
