Road Rules.

The following rules govern vehicles in the Parish of St. Mary, relative to speed, lighting, signals, right of way, etc. Violations of the rules are punishable with both fine and imprisonment:

Speed—Straightaway 35 miles per hour; road crossings, 20 miles per hour; elbow curves, 15 miles per hour; passing vehicles 25 miles per hour; passing through unincorporated villages, 20 miles per hour.

Lights—All power-driven vehicles, from sun-down to sun-up, must carry two white lights in front, and one red light in rear, on left.

Signals—All power-driven vehicles must sound warnings at curves, crossings, and in passing other vehicles, horsemen or pedestrians.

Passing—All vehicles must pass each other to the right going in opposite directions, and to the left going in the same direction.

Right of Way—All vehicles must keep to the right in traveling on the public roads, and a vehicle thus keeping to the right has the right of way and other vehicles must pass around it.

At night, vehicles carrying lights have the right of way at all times over those not carrying lights.

A penalty of fine and imprisonment for the violation of any of these rules is provided.

Sugar Crop Less.

Louisiana's 1915 sugar crop amounted to 137,500 short tons, or 275,000,000 pounds, according to final figures announced by the United States Bureau of Crop Estimates. A year before the total was 242,700.

Cane weighing 2,018,000 short tons, harvested from 183,000 acres in the state, was crushed during the season for sugar making. The average of sugar output per
