Bernie LaTour Dies From Effect of Accidental Gun Shot Wound.

The saddest accident that has occurred in this locality for many years happened Tuesday, from the result of which Bernie LaTour died in the evening. Bernie, a lad of about fifteen, the son of Mrs. Aline LaTour, was something of a nimrod often going out for a few hours shooting, either with companies or alone. Tuesday morning he started out early, and about seven o'clock shot a bird in the under growth east of the graveyard. Either while hunting for the bird, or going on after other game, his gun was accidentally discharged, the entire load striking him in the right side of the stomach, tearing a fearful hole into his body from which portions of the liver and intestines soon protruded. The place where this accident occurred was perhaps 100 yards from the road, and in this terrible condition Bernie spent the day, from about seven o'clock in the morning until late in the afternoon, before he was at length discovered. Apparently having despaired of being discovered where he was he had managed to work his way along, crawling on his back up to the road, where he was finally found and taken to the home of his mother.

Immediately upon being brought home he was given medical attention, but although conscious to the last he was unable to rally, and passed away within a few hours.

The funeral services were held in the Catholic church at 11 o'clock Tuesday morning, Rev. Father Peeters, of Jennings officiating, in the absence of Father Roubouts, Interment was made in the Catholic cemetery.

Out of respect to Bernie and his mother, sister and brothers, the public schools, of which he was an attendant were closed and practically all the pupils of his grades attended the funeral.

Mrs. LaTour and the other members of the family have the sincere sympathy of the entire community in their present sorrow.
