Scoggins, Rosamond R. Arceneaux, Wade E. Plauche, Lee E. Robinson, Elwin C. Willard, Joseph A. Verret, George R. Boling, William E. Faught and Arthur T. Jones, all residents of the Parish of Jefferson Davis, State of Louisiana, each of whom declared unto me in the presence of the hereinafter named and undersigned competent witnesses that they do hereby organize themselves into and create a body corporate in law and adopt the following articles of incorporation for the control of themselves and such other persons as may become associated with or succeed them.

Article I.
The name of said corporation is declared to be the **WELSH WAREHOUSE COMPANY**, under which name and title it shall enjoy all of the immunities, rights and privileges conferred by law upon corporations for a period of ninety-nine years from date hereof.

Article II.
The domicile of said corporation is declared to be in the town of Welsh, Parish of Jefferson Davis, State of Louisiana.

Article III.
The objects and purposes for which said corporation is formed are declared to be for the purpose of conducting a public or private warehouse business in the town of Welsh, Louisiana, or such other places as may be decided upon by the Board of Directors; to buy, own, sell, or lease real estate; to buy and sell feed, fertilizer, coal, oil, sacks, twine, machinery and generally all character of plantation or farm supplies, and to do all things incident to and connected with the conduct of either a private or public warehouse business, and the advancing or furnishing of supplies to farmers or planters.

Article IV.
The capital stock of said corporation is declared to be Twenty-five thousand (\$25,000.00) dollars, divided into two hundred and fifty (250) shares of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars each, and this corporation shall be authorized to commence business when said two hundred and fifty (250) shares of its capital stock has been subscribed for, each subscription must be accompanied with the payment of at least fifty per cent of the capital so subscribed; the remaining portion of said subscription shall be payable upon demand of the Board of Directors, but in no event shall it be paid later than January 15th, 1915. No certificate of stock shall be issued as evidence of ownership of stock until the purchase price thereof has been paid.

Article V.
The business affairs of this corporation and the management thereof shall be entrusted to a Board of Directors of not less than five nor more than nine stockholders, the number thereof to be determined for the ensuing year at each annual meeting of the stockholders, when said directors are selected. The directors until the first annual meeting of the stockholders, which shall occur on the 2nd Monday of January, 1915, are declared to be as follows: **Simpson O. Scoggins, Rosamond R. Arceneaux, Wade E. Plauche, Lee E. Robinson, Elwin C. Willard, Joseph A. Verret, George R. Boling, William E. Faught and Arthur T. Jones.**

Article VI.
The officers of said corporation are declared to be a President, a Vice President and a Secretary-Treasurer, who shall perform the duties usually incumbent upon such officers of a corporation, and such other duties as may, from time to time, be assigned to them by the Board of Directors. Until the first meeting of the stockholders on the 2nd Monday of January, 1915, the officers are declared to be, **Lee E. Robinson, President; Rosamond R. Arceneaux, Vice-President, and Joseph A. Verret, Secretary-Treasurer.**

Citations and other legal processes shall be served upon the President, or in his absence, on the Vice-President, and in the absence of both, upon the Secretary-Treasurer.

Article VII.
The stockholders of this corporation shall hold a regular annual meeting upon the second Monday of January, 1915, and annually thereafter, and the Secretary-Treasurer shall mail a written or printed notice to each stockholder to his last known postoffice address not less than fifteen days preceding said meeting, which notice shall state the hour, date and place of the meeting. The Board of Directors may call a special meeting at any time, as provided by law, in which event a similar notice shall be given to each stockholder at least fifteen days prior to said meeting, which notice of a special meeting in all respects must comply with the provisions of Act 257 of the Acts of 1914.



Article IX.



ORDINANCE NO. 66

Calling an Election Throughout the Parish of Jefferson Davis, State of Louisiana to take the Sense of the Qualified Electors in Said Parish as to Whether or Not There Shall be Granted Licenses for the Sale and Retail of Spirituous, Vinous, Malt and Intoxicating Liquors; Fixing the Date of said Election, and Appointing the Commissioners and Clerks in the Several Precincts Throughout Said Parish to Hold and Conduct Said Election, As provided by the General Election Laws and Constitution of the State of Louisiana.

Sec. 1. BE IT ORDAINED by the Police Jury of the Parish of Jefferson Davis, State of Louisiana, in regular session convened, that an election be, and the same is hereby ordered to take the sense of the duly qualified voters and electors in the Parish of Jefferson Davis and State of Louisiana, under the Constitution and laws of said State, as to whether or not there shall be granted licenses for the sale and retail of spirituous, vinous, malt and intoxicating liquors throughout the entire Parish of Jefferson Davis in said State.

Sec. 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED etc., That said election shall be held under the general election laws of the State of Louisiana so far as applicable, after due advertisement and the issuance of the proclamation of the President of the Police Jury as provided by law, on the First day of December, A. D., 1914, at each voting precinct in said parish.

Sec. 3. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, etc., That the ballots used at said election shall be in the following form:

FOR License throughout the Parish of Jefferson Davis, State of Louisiana.

AGAINST License throughout the Parish of Jefferson Davis, State of Louisiana.

Sec. 4. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED etc., That the following named persons are hereby appointed Commissioners and Clerks in the several voting, precincts throughout said Parish of Jefferson Davis to hold and conduct said election, nameiv:

Ward One, Precinct One—Joe Guidry, D. Richard, John Bonnin, Commissioner; and Geo. Bailey, Clerk.

Ward One, Precinct Two—Leroy Elliot, Oscar Aguilard, J. J. Langley, Commissioners; and J. L. Doiron, Clerk.

Ward Two, Precinct One—Jennings, A. E. Toups, W. E. Coffin, G. A. Connally, Commissioners; Roy K. Twitchill, Clerk.

Ward Three, Precinct One—Raymond; Frank Garry, B. Labouve, John Labouve, Commissioners; and Jule Bryan, Clerk.

Ward Four, Precinct One.—Elton; Nicholas Gaborin, T. O. Fuselier, F. Butler, Commissioners and O. W. Henderson, Clerk.

Sec. 5. Be It Further Ordained, etc., That the President of the Police Jury be and he is hereby authorized to issue his proclamation calling said election to be held at the voting precincts throughout said Parish as required by law, said election to be held on the 1st day of December, A. D. 1914, under the general election laws of the State so far as applicable, the polls to open at Six o'clock a. m. and to close at Seven o'clock p. m., on said day, and to make due returns thereof as required by law.

Sec. 6 BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED etc That the Police Jury of the Parish of Jefferson Davis, State of Louisiana shall meet at the parish seat in Jennings in said parish on the 18th day of September A. D. 1914, at 10 o'clock a. m. or as soon thereafter as possible for the purpose of canvassing the returns and declaring the result of said election.

Sec. 7. Be It Further Ordained, etc., That in the event that a majority of the voters entitled to vote in said election throughout said Parish of Jefferson Davis, State of Louisiana, shall vote in favor of the issuance of licenses for the sale and retailing of said spirituous and intoxicating liquors the same shall be effective on the 1st day of January A. D. 1915, and the Police Jury shall then pass an Ordinance fixing such licenses, etc., according to law.
