

OFFICIAL MINUTES OF THE JEFFERSON DAVIS PARISH POLICE JURY... The Police Jury of the Parish of Jefferson Davis, Louisiana, met in regular session at the Court House in Jennings, Louisiana, on this day at 9 o'clock a. m.

Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana, Fenton, La., Feb. 18, 1920. To the President and Members of the Police Jury of the Parish of Jefferson Davis: Gentlemen:—We, the undersigned, citizens of Jefferson Davis Parish, Louisiana, respectfully ask your Honorable Body to appoint six commissioners to lay out and procure right of way for a public road from where Pelican Highway intersects eastern boundary line of right of way of Mo. P. R. R. at Fenton, and thence in a southwesterly direction to the south line of section 2, Tp. 9, range 6 west, thence west to SE corner section 3-4-5.

The following resolution adopted the Board of Supervisors of the Pelican Road District No. One was introduced and motion was made by Mr. Briggs that the resolution be approved and confirmed by this Police Jury. The motion was seconded by Mr. Marcantel. Upon the adoption of this motion a yeas and nays vote was called, which resulted as follows: Arthur Guidry, Nay; R. M. Briggs, Yea; T. S. Walker, absent; J.
