SLIDELL PROTESTS CUTTING OUT ROAD

INVESTIGATION OF ST. TAMMANY POLICE JURY—RECORD KEEPING IS ASKED FOR.

ROAD IN GOOD ROADS PLAN

Civic League Adopts Resolutions and Asks Inquiry—Ward Nine Will Pay Approximately \$190,000 of the \$750,000 Bond Issue.

Slidell.—At a meeting of the St. Tammany police jury, held in Covington on Thursday, September 16, a resolution was passed by that body ordering the Good Roads Commission to cancel the contract for the hard-surfacing of the Slidell-Salt Bayou Road, in face of the fact that this road was outlined in the original good roads program.

In view of the fact that the Ninth Ward alone will pay approximately \$190,000 of the \$750,000 bond issue for good roads, the Slidell Commercial and Civic League, at a mass meeting, adopted the following resolutions of protest and asking an inquiry.

"Whereas, it has been brought to our attention that at a meeting of the police jury of the parish of St. Tammany, La., held at Covington, La., on Thursday, September 16, a resolution was in the nature of an instruction to the Good Roads Commission of the parish of St. Tammany to cancel a contract for the hard surfacing of the Slidell-Salt Bayou road, which contract had been previously recommended by the Good Roads Commission of the parish of St. Tammany and actually entered into between the police jury of the parish and a contracting firm known as the St. Tammany Construction Company and for an approximate sum of \$63,681.27 and work actually commenced and considerably advanced on the road, and

"Whereas, it is a notorious fact that the proposition put to the people of St. Tammany parish when the bond issue of \$750,000 was voted included this road in the schedule and that at least four members of the old police jury state positively that it was the intention to hard-surface the Slidell-Salt Bayou Road and remember this fact well, and

"Whereas, should this cancellation of the contract between the contractor and the police jury of the parish of St. Tammany be actually made there will remain less than one and one-half (1 1/2) miles of hard surfaced roads in Ward Nine for which contracts have been made by the Good Roads Commission of the parish, and

"Whereas, of the total bond issue of \$750,000 to be dispersed by the Good Roads Commission Ward Nine will pay approximately \$190,000 and

FOR HURRIED READERS.

For the convenience of the fair sex, the registration office will be open every evening until 6 o'clock. A few days ago Rayne women assembled to the number of 57 to sign the roll as new citizens.


Plauchville.—The storm struck this place with a very high wind followed by one of the heaviest rains ever experienced. Fully one-third of the open cotton was beaten to the ground. Sugar cane was laid flat on the ground. The loss of the farmers is heavy.

Morgan City.—Charles P. Lynch has been named cashier of the First National Bank of Morgan City, vice K. R. Hood resigned. Mr. Hood goes to San Antonio, Tex., where he will engage in business with his brother, Mr. Lynch was formerly assistant cashier.

Crowley.—City Manager Herpin, who was recently appointed by Crowley, attended the session of the Southwestern Waterworks Association held in New Orleans, and improvements will be made here as a result.

Morgan City.—Little or no damage was done in this immediate section by the storm recently. The wind reached a velocity of thirty-five miles an hour and except that a good many fences were laid down, no material damage was experienced by the crops.

Shreveport.—At least two dozen veteran musicians are expected to participate in the Old Fiddlers' Contest at the 1920 State Fair of Louisiana, which opens October 29 and will run eleven days. The contest will be held Tuesday morning, November 4.


